



## Year 7 Catch-up Premium Grant Report

Secondary schools receive the premium to help to support year 7 pupils who fail to reach the governments “expected standards” - previously a level 4 - reading and Maths by the time they leave primary school.

In 2018-19 the allocation of funds for this purpose to The Cumberland School was £20599.

In 2019 -20 the allocation of funds for this purpose to The Cumberland School is £24323.

Each year we use our catch-up premium to employ additional qualified English and Math teachers. We teach weaker students in small groups and booster sessions. During the academic year 2018-19 we will use our funding to employ additional teaching staff in the English and Maths departments.
