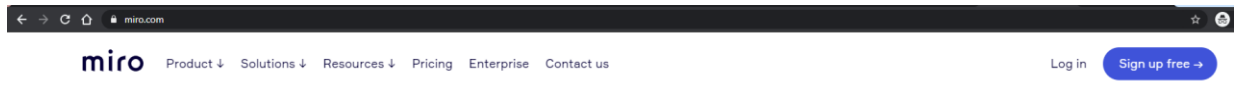




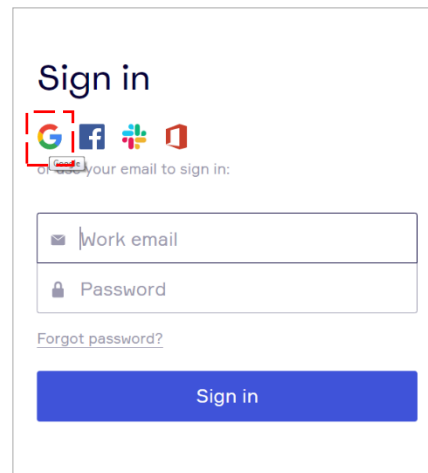
# Teachers guide on how to use miro

The online collaborative white boarding platform to bring teams together, anytime, anywhere.

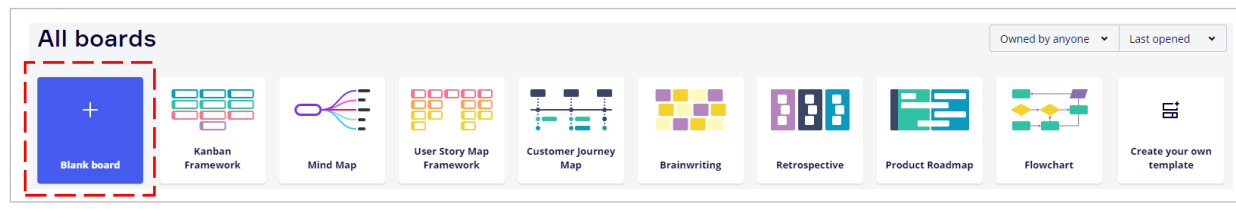
## Step 1 – Navigate to the Miro website www.miro.com



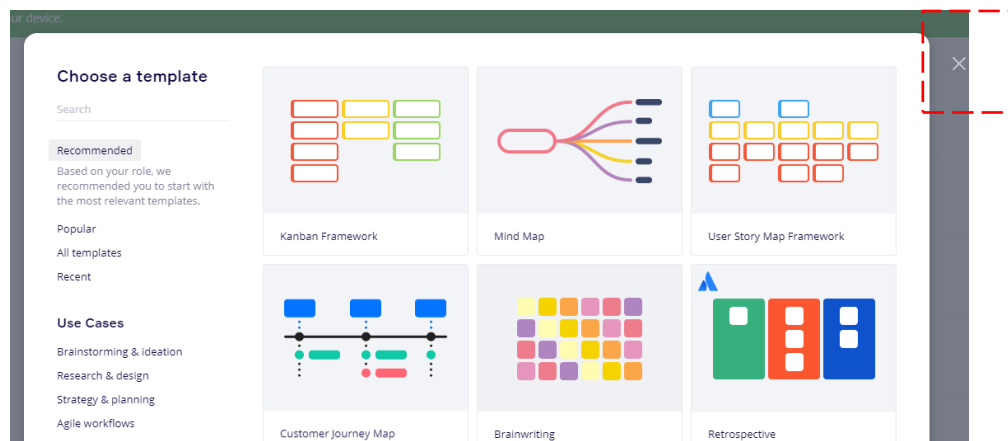
## Step 2 – Sign in by clicking on the google icon, your school Gmail account should link automatically.



## Step 3 – Once logged in select the 'Blank board' option

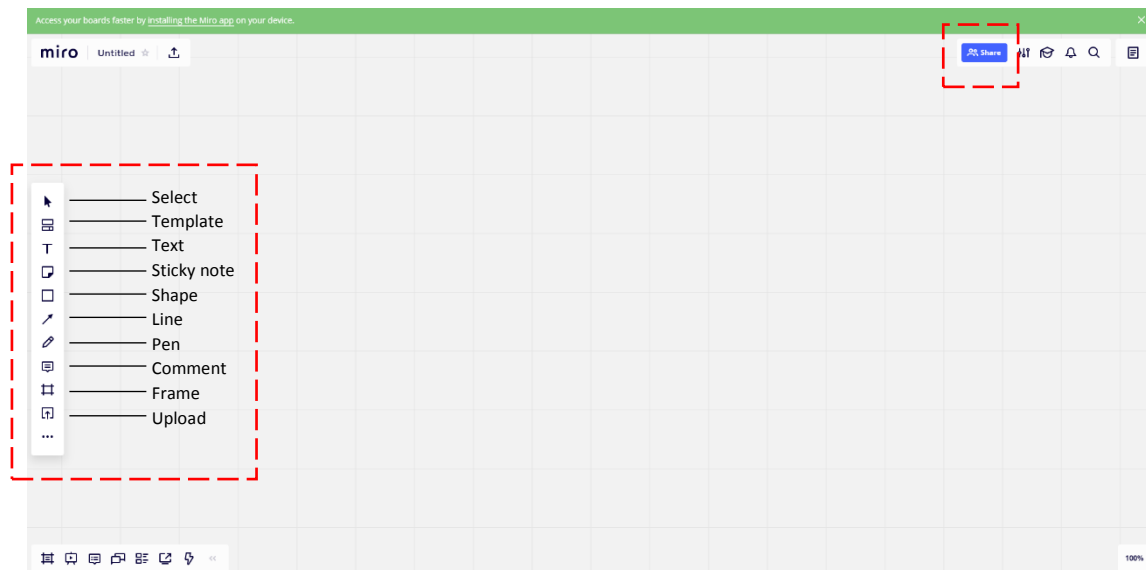


## Step 4 – Close the dialogue box when you are asked to choose a template by clicking on the x

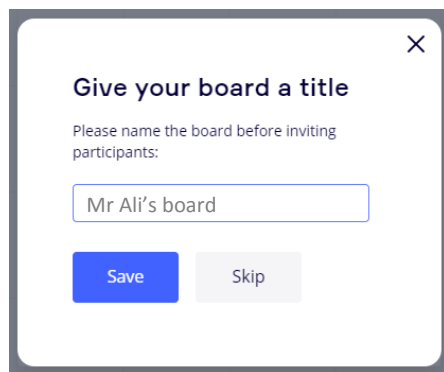


## Step 5 – miro interface

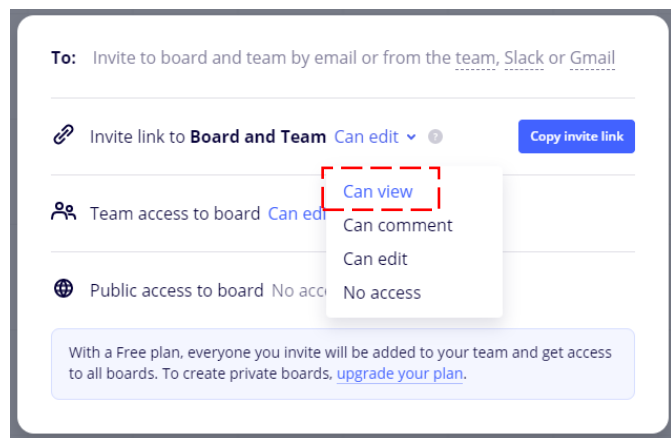
The miro interface is simple and straightforward to use. The main features you will use are the tools on the left hand side (highlighted) and the share button on the top right hand corner.



## Step 6 – Save your board by giving it an appropriate title



## Step 7 – Click on the share button to create a link **IMPORTANT:** Make sure to select 'Can view' option only



## Step 8 – Copy the link and paste it in the 'Additional Student Information' column of the Google sheet document available from the Virtual Classroom area
