Dear Parents/Carers



- Our student log in rates are looking brilliant - over 76% log in rate and we have just returned from Easter break. This is down to your support from home so I want to say a huge thank you!

- Early figures show that Year 7 attendance and work submission is the highest, followed closely by Years 10 and 9. I am rooting for Year 8 to catch up this week.
